

Description

Every year, between 250,000 and 1 million women in the United States are diagnosed with cervical dysplasia. While it can occur at any age, the peak incidence is in women between the ages of 25 to 35. Most dysplasia cases can be cured with proper treatment and follow-up. Without treatment, 30 to 50 percent may progress to invasive cancer.

Impact Statement

Participants will gain the skills necessary to counsel clients on the causes, symptoms, diagnosis and treatment of cervical dysplasia.
